On behalf of Louth Hockey Club I would like to welcome your child to the club and provide you with some information about our activities. The club provides opportunities for young people between the ages of seven and above to receive coaching and competition.

All coaching is by qualified coaches who are trained and have been screened for their suitability for working with young people.

We welcome parents to all training and competitions and value your support. Below is some information about training times and dates, and details regarding travel arrangements, kit and club registration.

Training sessions take place on Monday from 6.30pm to 7.30pm on the Astro Turf , The Sports Ground, London Road, LOUTH.

Arrangements should be made for your child to travel to and from training sessions and matches. We appreciate it if children can arrive and are collected promptly. If you are going to be late picking your child up, please contact myself, Maggie Bilcliffe, the Youth Officer on 07919378901 or Sue Gauntlett, the Club Secretary on 01790 753569 (07825545704) and let them know.

Club training kit consists of T shirt; sweatshirt/tracksuit top; tracksuit bottoms or long socks if using shorts; astro turf shoes or trainers with a good grip. We strongly recommend the advice of England Hockey that all players should wear shin, ankle and mouth guards. A drink is advisable at all times and also waterproof clothing should be brought when the weather looks doubtful.

The cost of each training session is £2.50p and competition fees are approximately £2.00p. The club has an associate/training membership fee of £20.00p, payable when the season starts and no later than the 31st October. The associate/training membership covers training, competitions and activities organised by the club and also give the members club insurance cover.

We would be grateful if you could complete the club membership form and return it, together with the membership fee, to either the Club's Treasurer or Secretary as soon as possible thank you.

For the safety of your child it is important that the club is informed of any medical condition or allergies that may be relevant should your child fall ill or be involved in an accident while at the club.
